PORT ROYAL LADIES' 9-HOLE GOLF ASSOCIATION

General Information

Any adult female Sports or Golf member of the Port Royal Plantation Club is eligible to become a member of the Association. Dues are \$40.00 annually payable by January 31. New members joining later in the year will be pro-rated.

If their USGA handicap is not established, new members must turn in five scores or more until a 27 or better 9-hole handicap is established. These scores must be submitted to the Handicap Chairwoman. (A USGA handicap for 18 holes will be accepted without handing in scores.) Members may have a handicap higher than 27. However, when they play in 9-hole sanctioned events, the maximum 9-hole handicap they may play to is a 27.

The deadline for signing up on the computer for Thursday play will be 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday. After the Director for the event has picked up the pairing sheets from the pro-shop on Wednesday, telephone calls will be made to the participants to advise them of their tee-off times even if it is a shotgun start. If you have previously signed up and find you cannot play, call the Director of the Month. You may also call the Director of the Month if you are late in signing up and she will determine if there is space available for you to play. Players must be in their carts 15 minutes before start time.

Meetings of the Association can be called by the Executive Committee and notifications will be posted on the bulletin board for such meetings.

BY-LAWS OF THE PORT ROYAL LADIES 9-HOLE GOLF ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I

A. Name

The name of the organization shall be "Port Royal Ladies' 9-Hole Golf Association."

B. Purpose

The purpose of the association is to encourage and promote the game of golf through friendly games among its members.

ARTICLE II

A. Qualifications

Any adult female of the Port Royal Plantation Club may obtain membership in the association by payment of annual dues.

1. New Members must play nine holes on any of our courses until five or more scores are submitted to the Handicap Chairwoman. They may join with a handicap greater than 27 but must play to a 27 in all 9-hole sanctioned events. (A USGA handicap for 9 or 18 holes will be accepted without handing in scores.)

2. Concurrent membership in the 9-hole Ladies Golf Association and the 18-hole Ladies Golf Association is not permitted. Transfer from 9-hole to 18-hole may be made at player's discretion, if qualifications are met.

B. Fiscal Year

The fiscal year begins January 1 and ends December 31.

C. Dues

Annual membership dues are forty dollars. Assessments for special purposes may be made only when proposed by the Executive Committee and ratified by two-thirds of the membership at a meeting of the members. Anyone joining after July 1st may have her dues pro-rated.

D. Delinquency

Payment of dues of current members must be made within thirty days after the annual meeting. The Treasurer shall then advise the members by telephone or letter of her delinquency and if not received within ten days, the member is ineligible to win prizes in the regular Thursday tournaments. After thirty days of delinquency, the member shall be dropped from the association.

ARTICLE III

A. Officers and Duties

The officers of the Port Royal Ladies' 9-Hole Golf Association shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, all of whom shall be elected by the members at the annual meeting. The term of office shall be for one year, and not more than two consecutive years, except for the Treasurer who may serve an open ended term.

1. The President shall preside at the annual meeting and executive meetings and shall appoint the Chairwomen of all regular and special committees, and delineate the duties of such committees.

2. The Vice President shall serve as Handicap Chairman and shall perform the duties of the President when required and such other duties as the President may delegate.

3. The Secretary shall keep the records and minutes of all meetings of the association, conduct correspondence and issue all notices proper to the office.

4. The Treasurer shall collect and distribute the funds of the association and keep proper records of all financial transactions.

5. The Tournament Chairman shall set up weekly events, tournaments and exchange days.

B. Nominating Procedures

The president shall appoint, by August 15, a nominating committee consisting of three members, one of whom shall be the Chairman. The committee shall propose names of members for the offices of President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and shall post the names on the bulletin board by September 1. Further nominations may be made in writing by any seven members by sending such nominations to the Secretary by the 10th of September. No ballots for persons other than those nominated shall be received or counted at the election.

ARTICLE IV

A. Executive Committee

The Executive committee shall consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Three members of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum.

B. Duties and Powers

It shall be the duty of the Executive Committee to carry out the objectives of the association, subject to these bylaws. It shall have the power to fill any vacancy in an elective office until the succeeding annual meeting and to make such rules and regulations, not inconsistent with these by-laws, as it deems necessary.

ARTICLE V

A. Meetings

1. A meeting of the members shall be at the discretion of the Executive Committee. A meeting shall be called by the Executive Committee at the request of any six members. Notice of meeting shall be posted on the bulletin board a week prior to such meetings.
2. The meeting held in September to plan the green book schedule shall be attended by the President, the President elect, the Tournament Chairman and the incoming Tournament Chairman and any other officers deemed necessary.

B. Quorum

Twenty-five percent of the members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the members.

C. Absentee Vote

Absent members shall have the right to vote by sending written notice to the Secretary prior to any meeting.

D. Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of the association shall be held on the second Thursday of December or as near that date as possible.

ARTICLE VI

A. 9-Hole Championship

You must have been a member in good standing of the 9- Hole Ladies Association for the past 12 months to play in the Championship Game.

ARTICLE VII

A. Amendments

These by-laws may be amended at any meeting of the members at which there is a quorum by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of those voting in person or by proxy. The Secretary must give each member ten days' notification prior to such action.
