### **Courts**

14 total courts - 10 HarTru clay courts, 4 cushioned hard courts, (2 hard courts are lighted).

### **Membership Features**

- A maximum of two hours a day reserved court time per membership unit with no court fees. Additional "walk on" court time may be had on a space available basis.
- Court reservations 7 days in advance.
- Reduced rates on private lessons and clinics.
- Charge privileges at Robber's Row Grill and the Port Royal Golf and Racquet Club pro shops, Shipyard Golf pro shop, and Reflections on the Green Restaurant.
- Discounts on merchandise at the pro-shops and restaurants.
- Newsletter, membership directory, and schedule of club social and tournaments.
- Opportunity to participate in "Members Only" social activities.

### **Membership Classifications**

Resident Members are those who reside on HHI or within a 100 mile radius who use the club facilities for more than five months during the calendar year.

Non-Resident Members are those who reside on HHI or within a 100 mile radius for five months or less during the calendar year. Whether the club facilities are used one day or every day in a month, the use is counted as one month's use by the membership unit.

Use of the club facilities in excess of five months within a calendar will automatically place the Non-Resident in the Resident category.

### **Membership Status**

Family: A husband, wife, and dependent children. A dependent shall be defined as one who is under 21 years of age, unmarried, and whose permanent residence is at home. Offspring 21 years of age and older are charged at "guest of member" rates unless they are dependent full-time students between the ages of 21 and 23.

Single: An individual 21 years of age or older.

House guests and immediate family: no charge (not to exceed 2 weeks in any one visit). The member should obtain guest passes at the Racquet Club.

### **Dress Codes**

Members are required to wear correct tennis attire on the tennis courts. Members are also urged to advise their guests of the dress code prior to the guests' arrival to avoid embarrassment. Please, no running shoes. Anyone not complying with the dress code may be asked to change their attire before gaining access to the Tennis Courts.

### **Activities**

There are Inter-Club and U.S.T.A. Leagues for both ladies and men. Those interested in league play should contact the Pro Shop. Take advantage of the Tennis Round Robins and member socials that are held throughout the year.

### **Instructional Programs**

There is a discount on all lessons, clinics and round robins.
