The Guest Policy for social activities as approved by the Board of Governors is:

In general, members may then invite guest who are not Landowners, but may not invite anyone living in Port Royal Plantation or a non-member spouse of a member. The exception to these restrictions as set forth below have been approved by the Board.

Because of the special nature of the Annual Invitational Golf Tournament, spouses who are not social members are allowed to participate.

To provide Prospective Members the opportunity to experience club activities, members and the Membership office are encouraged to invite them for a one-time attendance at a social activity. Approval beforehand is to be obtained from Ray Dznowski, Director of Operations, and Heritage Golf at 681-1703. These invitations can be extended to Landowners or others living in the Plantation.

There will be certain other events to which Landowners may be invited at the discretion of the Board.
