

## **GOLF-MEN'S**

The purpose of Men's Golf at Port Royal is to provide a means to promote fair, friendly and enjoyable golf. Any adult male sports or golf member in good standing of the Port Royal Plantation Club can be a participant in Men's Golf. There are no annual fees associated with being part of Men's Golf except those fees necessary to be a member of the Port Royal Plantation Club. There are fees for participants who wish to enter the events which occur throughout the year. New members who do not have an official USGA handicap from another club will be allowed to play as non-participating players until such time as they establish official handicaps. Please see Heritage Golf's Members Coordinator in the Pro Shop for further details.

### **MEN'S GOLF COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS**

The officers of Men's Golf shall consist of a Chairman, and a committee of not less than four committeemen. The Chairman of Men's Golf shall be appointed by the Golf Committee Chairperson with approval of the PRPC Board of Governors for a term of one year with a limitation of two consecutive terms. The Chairman of Men's Golf with the approval of the Golf Committee Chairman shall appoint for a calendar year those full golfing members who shall constitute The Men's Golf Committee, and shall appoint such replacement members as are required during the year. The Chairman has the responsibility of insuring that the participants are provided with a full calendar of approved and customary events for the weekly Wednesday and Saturday games. In order that the participants may take advantage of Island wide events, the chairman shall also, with the approval of the Golf Committee Chairperson, appoint Captains of the Inter-Club and Low-country Inter-Club Teams.

### **MEN'S GOLF COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Men's Golf Committee exists for the express purpose of ensuring an enjoyable golf experience for the male members of the Port Royal Plantation Club. The Chairman will, if necessary, designate one of the other committee members to perform his duties if circumstances require it. The committee shall also review all tournament rules and selection procedures to insure that every participant is accorded a fair and equal opportunity to participate in club events. In the event of rules disputes or violations, the Committee and a Pro Shop representative shall serve as the Rules Committee and will utilize all available sources to render correct decisions. The committee will have the right to assess reasonable non-monetary penalties for violations of club rules. Any penalties assessed must conform to the By-Laws of the Port Royal Plantation Club.

### **WEEKLY EVENTS**

Those participants wishing to play in the Saturday Blitz and Wednesday Men's Day events are required to sign up in advance in the Pro Shop. Those participants who sign up and do not show are subject to a two week suspension of playing privileges for the event missed. A participant who has signed up, but cannot play should inform the golf professional and have his name deleted, or call the Pro Shop one hour before the starting time of the event. In the event that there are ties in the weekly events, the total of the prizes for the positions tied will be split equally between the tied contestants. The one exception is when the tie is for the last place to be awarded a prize, in which case the tie will be settled by a matching of cards using USGA recommended procedures.

## **PARTICIPATION IN TOURNAMENTS EVENTS**

Resident members wishing to participate in major tournaments must have recorded eight scores for official handicap purposes during the preceding three months before the tournament. Members having a GOLD membership status and non resident members who wish to play in these tournaments may use their current lowest index (subject to the above rule) converted into a Port Royal handicap as their handicap. This restriction does not apply for non handicap play. Posting of tournament scores will be done by Heritage Golf personnel. All participants in men's events, except guest in guest day events, must be members in good standing of the PRPC.

## **TOURNAMENT EVENTS**

Members, when signing up for major tournament events, are expected to participate in the full event. Failure to participate or withdrawal from the event could result in suspension from future men's golf events. This included second, third and consolation rounds. Extra hole sudden-death playoffs are to start on the first hole of the members course.

## **SATURDAY BLITZ GAMES**

Each week - 2 best balls of 4 - 100% Hcp. The last Saturday of each month will be flighted if possible. Starting times are 9:00 a.m. January through April and October through December. May through September events start at 8:30 a.m.

## **BLACK TEES**

Members may play from the black tees during any Wednesday Men's Day or Saturday Blitz events provided they are at least 75 years of age. These events are normally played from the white tees. Due to computer limitations the cards are printed for white tees handicaps. Those who opt to play the black tees must make a handicap adjustment for the difference in slope and course rating as follows:

- A. Use the black tee handicap for the course played from the computer (usually one stroke lower).
- B. Reduce your handicap printed on the card by the difference in course ratings for black/white tees. This reduction is 3 strokes for Barony and Robber's Row, and 2 strokes for Planter's Row.

The purpose of the Inter-Club teams is to select the most competitive teams to represent The Port Royal Plantation Club in the Inter-Club matches. These matches are normally played weekly in the first half of the year. The current maximum allowable handicap is 18 for the Inter-Club and 20 for the LowCountry Inter-Club Team. Handicaps can be changed by the Inter-Club governing bodies.

**SELECTION PROCEDURES**

The playing teams will be selected from those members who sign up and pay the appropriate fee(s) by the published (in the men's locker room) dates. Any member meeting the handicap requirements on the sign up date is eligible to play on the particular team. The basis for selection to the playing team will be as follows:

1. Performance in previous Inter-Club competitions.
2. Member's ability to play to current handicap.
3. Performance in the previous year's three major tournaments sponsored by the PRPC:  
winners and runners-up in the championship, the first, and the second flights of the following:
  - Individual Match Play tournament
  - Club Championship tournament
  - Two-Man Match Play tournament

When Inter-Club matches are completed, members will receive a refund for matches not played and share in any winnings the team may accumulate, based on the number of matches played.
